	Wanted to make the PC aware of the rules and regulations regarding keeping captive birds RESOLVED that information regarding this has been published on the PC website and a notice is in the Council office window

Would like to see more seating in the town RESOLVED that this is being investigated
Dog fouling in the town has become extremely prevalent and suggests engaging the services of a dog warden
RESOLVED that the PC to look into more signs and the possibility of a dog warden
Vandalism in the town by young members of the community, would like to see a police presence around school home time and early evening RESOLVED that the Clerk to report vandalism to the Police and look into engaging a dog warden
 Parishioner contacted the Parish Council to raise the following points:- a. Requesting that the Council ask that another streetlight be provided near the entrance to the new building development on the Netherby Road b. Expressed concern that had read in local press that more houses are being considered for the Brampton Road in a town with very limited amenities and facilities ie. Shops, doctors, no dentist and no education facilities for the older age group. Infrastructure does not appear to provide necessary support for more properties

A few things to report:
a) I have managed to get the closure of the recycling centre at the front of the Community Centre put on hold. There are obviously problems with the current location, so any ideas that you have about how this could be better provided much appreciated. My starting position is that we do not want to lose a recycling centre in Longtown.
 b) Residents have been in touch about the potential need for a SID on the Old Road. I think they have a good point, not sure if that could be the subject of a future funding bid (residents have also contacted the PC) RESOLVED to look at funding for this
 c) The last time I was at a meeting I raised the issue of dog fouling in the Old Road area. As I understand this is still an issue, and there is probably a good case for moving a bin there if you have the capacity or flexibility? RESOLVED that the PC to investigate funding for a bin providing that it can be emptied
 d) I have been in touch with highways about correcting the SIDs on Netherby Road and Moor Road needing to be set at the legal speed limit (which is 30mph). After initially

	saying that they would come back a rectify the issue, they are now saying that the Parish Council have the keys, so you can do this yourselves

	 e) There have been further complaints about anti-social behaviour around the circular bus shelter outside the primary school. My understanding is that there is general agreement that this needs to be removed so I have asked for this to happen. Please let me know if this isn't right. RESOLVED that the PC to ask Cumberland Council if it can be moved to a different location
	 f) Planning application now received for new houses; I think it is the land to the north of Briar Lea Close off the Brampton Road. Please let me know if the PC has any objections that you would like me to raise on this. As I understand this isn't currently allocated as housing land, but it is clearly 'infill' between existing development. Let me know what you think RESOLVED that the Councillors' concerns are to be sent to Cllr Pickstone
