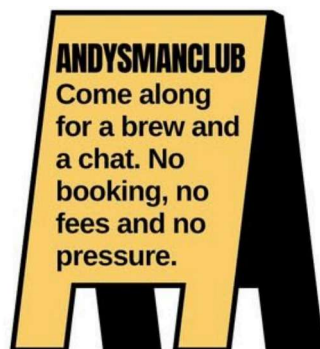

Cumberland Council is launching a
